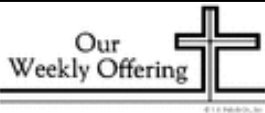

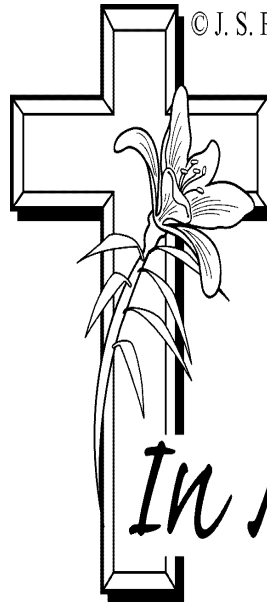

From Fr. Gary's pen...

Prior to the last days of his earthly life, Jesus was never sick nor did he experience physical pain of any sort. He started to know suffering and pain after he was arrested in the Mount of Olives. By His patience, silence and resignation to the Will of His Father, Jesus gave us a splendid example of how we must try to deal with sickness and pain.

Also, Jesus provides us with a second point of meditation regarding sickness and the care of the sick. During His ministry, Jesus went about the villages devoting himself to curing every manner of illness. In performing these acts of kindness, He best exemplified his message, contained in the Gospel of St. Matthew "I was ill and you comforted me."

Those of us who are sick should derive comfort and consolation in the belief that Jesus will also come and comfort us. As He did this personally in the past, now He does this through the help of His devoted followers; we are His feet, His hands, His eyes, His mouth who bring comfort and consolation in His name.

We take heart from the compassionate example of Jesus but also from Mary, His mother, under the title of Our Lady of Lourdes (Feb. 11) and saints like St. Blaise (Feb. 3 and Blessing of throats). We also know that St. Francis of Assisi suffered so many sicknesses but never lost faith or patience. In fact, during the height of some of his most painful days, he was able to write and even sing his song to God, the Canticle of Brother Sun. All of us, whatever our condition in life, share in the building of the City of God that is to come. In that heavenly city, the leaves of the tree along the river of life will cure us forever of all our physical and spiritual infirmities (see Rv. 22:2). Deo Gratius!!

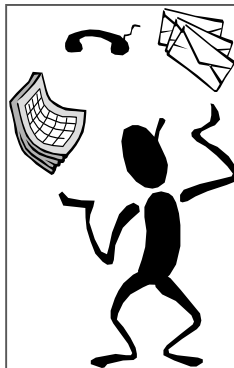

Kenrick-Glennon Seminary will be hosting an Open House on Sunday, February 16th from 1:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m.

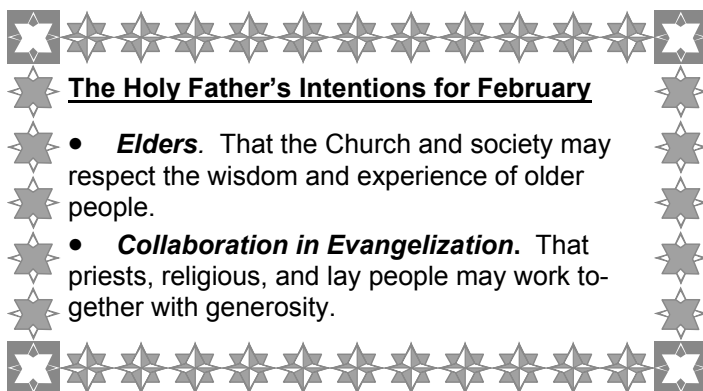

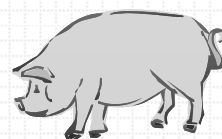
